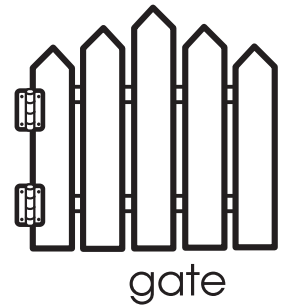
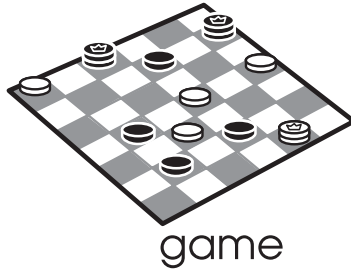
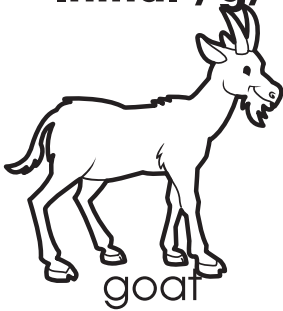


Practice /g/ Sound
