

LOGAN-ROGERSVILLE RETURN TO PLAY 2020

The Logan-Rogersville Activities Department will make the following changes in its day-to-day practices for the foreseeable future in regards to school-related activities. The decision to make these changes to our practices and contests is centered around providing the safest environment possible for our students and staff. We will continue to collaborate with local health officials and make changes as needed to ensure the safety of everyone involved. The goal is to create a safe environment that will provide the best opportunity for our students to compete for an entire season this school year. We appreciate your support in this goal.

Practice and Competition

- Temperature checks will be conducted each day prior to practice or competition. If a coach or student has a temperature above 100°, he/she will be sent home.
- Any student exhibiting symptoms as outlined by the <u>LR Return to Learn Plan</u> will be sent home.
- All programs will keep a record of daily attendance and when possible, a seating chart.
- Hand sanitizer will be used prior to and during practice/competition.

Masking (PPE)

- Masks are required for participants, coaches/directors and officials any time they are not involved in strenuous physical activity, unless physical distancing guidelines can be followed.
- All coaches and students will wear a mask inside the locker room, during team meetings, film, before and after practice, or at any other team functions.
- All students will be provided a mask or buff/gaiter by the LR Activities Department.

Cleaning Measures

- Equipment worn, such as football helmets/batting helmets/individual protective pads/uniforms, should be worn by only one individual and not shared.
- Athletic and activity facilities will be disinfected between each practice or game.
- No shared towels or clothing between participants.

Hydration

- Students must bring their own personal water bottle/container. Water bottles should not be shared.
- Communal drink stations will not be available.



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Transportation

- Students and coaches/directors must wear masks at all times while in school transportation vehicles.
- Students will have assigned seats to help with contact tracing.

Return to Play



Students exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to a positive COVID-19 case must follow the guidelines as outlined in the <u>LR Return to Learn Plan</u> before returning to play.

Students with a positive COVID-19 test result must follow the guidelines as outlined in the <u>LR</u> <u>Return to Learn Plan</u> and follow MSHSAA protocols before returning to play.

Spectators

- Masks are required at all times for indoor events and required at outdoor events when spectators are out of their seat entering/exiting/concession/restroom/etc. for all ages two (2) and older.
- Physical distancing is required at all times when spectators are not sitting with their family unit (household).
- Students and young children must remain seated with parents at all times during the entire event. The exception is students seated in the student body section.
- Logan-Rogersville School District will utilize the facility capacity guidelines set by the Springfield-Greene County Health Department to determine the number of spectators allowed to attend athletic/activity events. Admission will be closed when the administration determines physical distancing is no longer possible due to capacity limitations.
- As students travel and compete across the region, the spectator capacity and masking policy will vary by facility/community. LR strongly encourages masking and physical distancing.

We understand these precautions are an inconvenience and not ideal. However, we believe they give our students the best opportunity to reach the goal of a full season of activities. We appreciate your support of this goal.

Youth activities and groups using LR facilities are expected to follow the same procedures.
