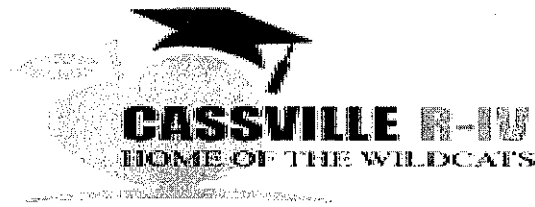

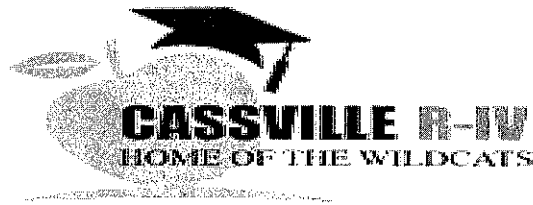

URGENT MESSAGE TO ALL INCOMING SENIORS

This is a reminder to all incoming Seniors for the school year 2021/2022.

All Seniors **MUST** have received the MCV (Menactra) vaccine **BEFORE** they will be allowed to pick up **SCHEDULES AND LOCKERS**. If you received the vaccine before the age of 16, you **MUST** receive a booster. Please drop off all official documents to the High School Office.

This is a Missouri State Law and seniors will not be able to attend school until they are compliant.

For your convenience, the Care Mobile will be coming to Cassville High School on May 24, 2021. Any student is able to receive required vaccinations through the Care Mobile. The Care Mobile will be providing immunizations at no cost for Medicaid and uninsured students. Insured students need a copy of the front and back of the student's insurance card.

If you are interested in using this service, please contact Nurse Boles to be added to the list and complete a Care Mobile registration form. Forms are available in the Nurse Office.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The State of Missouri requires that all students entering twelfth Grade receive a second meningococcal vaccine. There are two brand names of the meningococcal vaccine: Menactra and Menveo.

Your student will need a meningitis vaccine prior to twelfth grade.

Your student may receive the vaccine from several sources:

1. Your health care provider by appointment. Make sure your doctor's office stocks vaccines.
2. Barry County Health Department if you have Medicaid or are uninsured for vaccines M-Th 7:30 am - 6 pm.
3. From your local Pharmacy
4. Cox Health Care Mobile (on site at Cassville Schools on select dates).

For your convenience the Care Mobile will be on campus at the High School on **May 24, 2021**. If you would like for your child to receive their Meningococcal immunization at that time, please send a note or contact the High School to be added to the list. *The Care Mobile will see students with private insurance, Medicaid or uninsured. If you choose to utilize the Care Mobile, please send a copy (front and back) of your student's insurance card.*

We wanted to give you and your student plenty of time to make plans and receive the required doses.

twelfth graders will need to provide the school with written documentation of the vaccine(s) given with month/day/year, **prior to receiving their schedule or locker assignment next year.**
